- Assuming interest level is high enough contact Patti or John and set a date for a virtual demonstration meeting.
- Market the demo meeting and ask for confirmation of attendance.
- Present the demo meeting and encourage members to complete membership applications. Set date for next meeting electing officers. Select time and dates for future virtual meetings.
- Prepare furnished Excel template listing members and contact information.
