# District Alignment

- Division A
  - No club movement within areas needed
    - Area 5 newly chartered club added, (Climateers Toastmasters)
  - 18 clubs, in four areas

# District Alignment

- Division B
  - adjustments made affecting two clubs
    - Plus Factor
    - Bulls & Bears
  - These movements were recommended for Area 3 and Area 16
  - These changes are positive for the division

# District Alignment

- Division C
  - Recommends moving Smedley Hometown Memorial to Division F, Area 17
  - No club loss indicated

# District Alignment

- Division F
  - Most areas in good shape
  - Smedley club will be a part of Area 17



# District Alignment

- Division E
  - Area 21 is the only area with 3 clubs.
    - An area must have a minimum of 4 clubs at the start of the year
    - Moving the Wentzville MO Pros club to Area 21 brings the club count up to 4.
    - There is a new club added to Area 22 (Inroads Toastmasters)
      - Placed here to shore up the eastern edge of Division E
    - At least one net club growth needed next year.

# District Alignment

- The recommendation is to accept the alignment plan as provided.
  - Some zero member clubs may drop from the TI roster next year. If club count falls below four, the affected area will remain in tact through the remainder of the TM year.
  - Discussion with any concerns noted ( all areas must have at least four clubs on July 1)
  - Voting approval
