MID YEAR AUDIT REPORT – Elaine Curry Chair, presented by Tom.

Findings: No violations to report.

Recommendation: At every annual council meeting, Finance Manager should report the dollar amount of district funds not spent for the current year that the district will risk losing. The goal is to know how much to have an opportunity to use it before it is lost.

Jackie – Does the money that has been allocated in a category have to be spent in the category designated? Karen – yes it must stay in that category. Tom mentioned that there are sometimes exceptions, but they must be justified.

Rhonda: Do we need to make a motion to insist that the FM makes this report of amount not spent, can it just be a part of the FM responsibilities?

Tom: motion to adopt the recommendation and then added to the procedures?



Karen: is this something we propose to be include in next year changes to our procedures, to use going forward?

Tom: Only add this year or wait until next year.

Herman: Did we lose \$30,000 last year? Tom Yes Herman: was the budget adjusted this year? Tom: yes, these are basically extra funds. Karen: explained that we have what seems like excess due to lack of growth. (ERP upgrade, Self-Pay and Pathways -user friendly) they had a budget, but users decline. TMI can take a vote and reclaim a percentage. We had until June 30 to get on track. We could have spent money at the TMI store. But not at that volume. Not spending the promotional money to promote our district.

Tom: do you think this will be every year?

Karen: I do not have that impression. At all hands peer all, TI has the option each year to take the reserves, but they do not exercise it.

Rhonda: They start the excess funds in 2018-2019. Then pandemic and revenue when down they paused on taking the excess to allow districts to use for rebuilding the clubs.

Tom: How much are we at risk dollar wise if we do not spend it?

Karen: I will ask.

Herman: repeated his question.

Tom: Yes, with 30K less.

Karen: when we make X to spend but the money that they held, so we did not have to adjust our budget this year because we did not have access to the money that could be reclaimed.

KAREN suggest an amendment to not change our procedures this year but make note of it and pass it to the next trio. Recommend it as a procedural change. Mention this at each DEC meeting and not wait to til end to assist with keeping informed and accountable.

TOM: Suggests POSTPONE indefinitely and bring it up next year.

KAREN: ask if there are any have questions to following the recommendation but not adding it to procedures next year?

Rhonda, there was not motion or second made. So, Karen has the authority to take the recommendation and move forward. She does not hear that Tom made a motion.

Paula: why is it not a good thing to know the overage before losing it?

Karen: we have reviewed our procedures already. We would have to create a committee and it has been disbanded.

No opposition to postponement.



Report of the audit committee has been received and we are ready to move on.

Karen: asked for motion to adopt add an advisory report.

Art Stanze: I move that District 8 adopt the district advisory report. (No second needed-because it came from a committee)

Rhonda: Since it is an advisory report and not a nomination report, I recommend that this is not sent out to the district.

Karen: Because of that, all candidates must send DD their intent to run. When they publish the report (virtual showcase) of the qualified floor candidates and send a list to the District Council Members for awareness. If the DEC does approve, then it can be published to the site? Rhonda, a candidate that is qualified that notified the DD, will they be on the list.

Karen: two types – Qualified and Eligible and she explained both. Everyone on this advisory report is qualified.

Rhonda: all the candidates that declared themselves be on the ballot.

Tom: They need to let Karen know 7 days out.

Karen: We are planning a candidate corner on the morning of April 15. It will be open to eligible or qualified. Candidates will be allowed to make an appeal to the district council. Eligible candidates will be able to have the opportunity to make an appeal. Only qualified candidates will appear on the website and sent forth as advised. Eligible will campaign, be a part of Candidate corner and make an appeal.

DISTRICT ALIGNMENT REPORT – Tim Spezia Chair Committee includes div directors. Proposed district changes.

Changes include assigning new clubs. Moving clubs form one area to another. Maintain the area to 4-6 clubs.

Requirements: By July 1 all areas must have on 4-6 clubs No area can have less than four clubs. No div can have less than 3 areas.

No clubs have been contacted. No new club development this year.

DIV A – AREA 2 1 club closing due to merge. Moved a club from Area 16 16 remains 16.

DIV B - Area 13 - 1 club close Propose close area 16 and move remaining clubs to area 13 and area 2. 15 to 13 clubs

DIV C – Area 1 – 1 club closing Concerned about Montgomery County Area 10 – 1 club closing Area 11 – 1 club closing 19 to 18 clubs remain – avoid area loss.

DIV E – Area 7 – 1 club closings Received 2 clubs from area 22.



Area 20 – receiving 1 club from area 22.

Area 22 - 1 club closing and remaining clubs move to area 7 and 20. 15 to 14 clubs

DIV F-

Area 8 1 club closing and receiving a club from Area 19 Area 19 – 1 club moving to Area 8 Area 17 – has minimum work on gain more clubs. 24 remain at 24.

TOTAL DISTRICT 89 club to 85 clubs

Tim made a motion.

Charice – how do you determine how a club is moved?

Tim – generally it is geographically but other times it is based on the need. Also looked at putting stronger clubs with weaker clubs to provide as mentor clubs.

Karen added that there are clubs in the works. If a new club is added before the end of the year, it would be assigned to an area that has a need. They reassess then reassigned if warranted.

Tim: this is the proposed alignment for 2023-2024. Around February the committees begin looking at the alignment.

Jackie: who notifies the clubs of the change?

Karen: will make the connection and field the questions. It will include the division and area directors.

Tim: present it to the president and they can present to their club.

Paula: Where would the members go?



Tim: a merged club start attending the merged club. If it is a closed club and there are no members, then any remaining can join another club.

Karen called vote. 18 hands for; 0 hands opposed.
