What's in a Winning Contest Speech? Presenter: Pamela Rodney

It has been 22 years since District 8 has had a finalist representing at the TI World Championship. Our very own finalist has never competed in Toastmasters. Not too bad for a first timer. In this breakout, Pamela will share with you her techniques for writing her speech and other techniques to help you deliver a memorable presentation.

Stretch for Success Presenter: Lisa Bianco

Certified Yoga Instructor and President of Cave Springs
Toastmasters Lisa Bianco will lead you in this simple yoga class.
This class will be done in your chair (no mat or experience required!) More people than ever say they are so stressed that they cannot reach their goals. Yoga helps you destress your mind and body and invigorate your soul to get you back on your path to success. We will be learning to slow it down to reach your goals faster...especially all your Toastmasters speaking goals!

Rest Stop – Meditation/Breathing Presenter – Lawson (CAL) Calhoun, DTM

This class will teach you exercises to help you if you find yourself getting stressed. You will learn techniques on Deep Breathing, Mental Relaxation, Muscle Tension, and Guided Imagery. Another strategy you will learn is the Cognitive Triangle illustrating how thoughts, emotions, and behaviors affect one another – based on Cognitive Behavior Therapy (CBT). Each of these can be used at your discretion as you feel stressed and/or to avoid stress.

All About Meetup and Using it to Attract New Members Presenter: Ray "RJ" Stratton, DTM

Did you know that District 8 sponsors (i.e. pays for!) groups on Meetup.com, a website that lets people search for local clubs and events that match their interests? This is a fantastic tool to help clubs connect with people in their communities and add new members. In this course, you will have the answers to the following questions: What is Meetup.com? Why use Meetup to promote your club? Which clubs can use it? How do I sign up my club? Get the answers to these questions and so much more in this session.

The Delicate Balancing Act Presenter: Dr. Tara Phelps-Jones

Do you feel overwhelmed or stretched too thin? Are you juggling career, family and life in general? If so, this interactive workshop is tailor made just for you. This presentation will identify causes of imbalance and assist you in developing effective work-life balance strategies and techniques.

Great Contests on Any Platform Presenter: Art Stanze

This session will help contest host put on a great set of speech contests; on-line, hybrid, or in-person. How do you put on a speech contest that runs smooth and that contestants, officials, and audience enjoy? Are online contests more or less work for the Contest Chair, Contest Master, and Chief Judge?? He has competed in Table Topics at the area level. He has competed in Evaluation at division level. He helped plan and served as Contest Master for District 8's first online contest.

In this class, you will learn to navigate a few of the exercises offered to to help you prepare for your next Toastmasters speech or practice for an upcoming speech contest.

CPR: Catch, Pause, and Respond – Impromptu Speaking Skill Presenter: Yolandea Wood, DTM

Speaking-on-the-fly aka impromptu speaking will always be around. That is why we prepare to be ready when that seemingly random question is asked we need to respond quickly in daily conversation. This class will also prepare us to compete in this year's Table Topics speech contest in the Spring. Yolandea uses an interactive approach and shares how we can use this tool to our advantage.

Fueling Your Body for the Journey Presenter: Yolandea Wood, DTM

Start a Club or Sponsor a New Club Presenter: Patti Howard, DTM

This session is for all members interested in giving back and serving a new club or serving the district with starting a new club. As a Club Mentor, you advise and coach the new club helping them to build a strong foundation for their success. As a Club Sponsor, you would work with the existing club champions in organizing the new club. In addition to helping our district grow clubs, completing either of these roles will give you credit towards achieving your Distinguished Toastmaster award. If you have thought about how you can contribute your leadership skills, come listen and get all your questions answered.



Meet Your Presenters


