Rest Stop – Meditation/Breathing Presenter: Lawson (CAL) Calhoun, DTM



Public Relations.

This class will teach you exercises to help you if you find yourself getting stressed. You will learn techniques on Deep Breathing, Mental Relaxation, Muscle Tension, and Guided Imagery. Another strategy you will learn is the Cognitive Triangle illustrating how thoughts, emotions, and behaviors affect one another – based on Cognitive Behavior Therapy (CBT). Each of these can be used at your discretion as you feel stressed and/or to avoid stress.

This class is an introduction to Parliamentary Procedure and how it can be used in a Toastmaster's meeting. Roberts Rules of Order is the foundation of this procedure. We will go through a basic introduction to learn how we use these rules. Participants will receive cheat sheet to know what to say and a chart of motions to be prepared for any meeting. Finally, there will be an interactive role

play meeting to practice using the parliamentary procedures.
