Message from your Club Growth Director

As your Club Growth Director, my focus has been memberships and club renewals. Hats off to all the clubs and individuals that have reached out in sharing Toastmasters with others. These new members are comprised of family, friends, co-workers or others that responded to personal invitations, public invitations through Face Book postings, Meetup, or flyers shared with the general public. Several reached out and set up table displays at organizations to share about Toastmasters.

Even though several clubs dissolved this past year, your invitations and personal growth that others have seen, have kept the District 8 membership level from significant loss. We created several membership incentives for clubs and individuals this year. Individuals had a chance to receive a Toastmaster Document Bag and Travel Mug by renewing their memberships early. Several incentives were designed for clubs. For the Talk Up Toastmasters Membership Drive, two clubs, F.R.B Club (Federal Reserve Bank) and Rent-A-Toast Club (Enterprise) each received \$50 in Tl gift certificates by adding 5 new members during February and March in addition to the Tl incentives.

Seventy-seven (77) clubs have added members this past year. Of those, fifty-two (52) added four members achieving DCP Goal #7 with eighteen (18) of those clubs adding another 4+ members achieving DCP goal #8. The EOY Club Incentive will give clubs a \$5 TI gift certificates per each member that joins between March 1 – Jun 30 up to five members per each club. So far, fifty-two clubs will be receiving those certificates with a few more days to go. Eleven clubs have already maxed out on the EOY Incentive by adding at least 5 members. They are: Centene Speaks, RGA Toastmasters, Sole Influencers, Speak Easy Toastmasters, Aerospace Orators, Mastertoasters, Techmasters, MilliPoreSigma Toastmasters, Grand Center Club, and Rent-A-Toast Club.

Message from your Club Growth Director (cont.)

Three new clubs have chartered this year. Rhonda Green help to charter Writer's Ink in July 2023 and Charice Manor helped charter STL/Arnold in May 2024. Our third club, Speak Out Pfizer chartered in Oct 2023 with the help of sister clubs in 2 other districts. As we close out this year, 3 other D8 Toastmasters have given us leads for their workplace. Karen Dew and Elaine Curry are busy scheduling meetings and setting up demo meetings. We are hoping that they will charter soon to start the new year off with a bang!

A big thank you to Elaine Curry, Annetta Works Salley, Karen Dew, Lemont Curry, Kesha Kent, Sarah Van Meter, Lawson Calhoun, Jackie Kam Blackard, Trisha Gordon and Burchell McGhee in going with me to introductory meetings. While several have worked in the background to help coach clubs, four stepped up to be official club coaches. A big thanks to Kathy Dieker, Sarah Van Meter, Terri Orban and Charice Manor for working with clubs.

It has been my privilege to serve as your Club Growth Director this past year. I have met many that I would not have met, had I not had this opportunity. I have enjoyed visiting clubs virtually and those in-person club meetings. I look forward to serving you next year as your Program Quality Director.
