1. Officer Training
 - a. 57 Clubs that achieved goal 9B with 5 clubs having no officers attend training
 - b. Hats off to the following areas: A2, A4, A9, B3, B13, C6, E7, E14 that had the clubs in their areas (barring those closing) achieving goal #9.
2. Speech Contest
 - a. I'm disappointed with the lack of involvement of clubs participating. I will take the blame for that with lack of communication and training in preparing for them.
 - b. The Division Contests are next up.
3. Distinguished Clubs
 - a. The District goal is 31 distinguished clubs.
 - b. What is the one requirement for receiving TI achievement as a Distinguished club – membership of either 20+ members or base + 3
 - c. 7 clubs have reached distinguished if they keep their membership at 20 or more: South County, Noontime (MO), Capital City, Horace Mann, Collinsville, Toast of Belleville, MasterToasters &, Cave Springs
 - d. 33 clubs have the potential – let's help them. 12 clubs just need to work on their educational goals; 2 clubs just need more members and the 19 remaining need a combination of members & education.
 - e. Next emphasis will be on Pathways – during my time training officers, most didn't understand how to complete their project in Pathways; then the VPE (or other officer) will check Base Camp Manager, check approvals and then verify.
 - f. 25 clubs without 1 education level completed; 12 clubs with just 1 level completed
